

Board of Directors Election:

Your **Voice**. Your **Cooperative**. Your **Vote**.



How the Board is Structured

- Our service territory is divided into 9 districts.
- Each district is represented by one director.
- Directors serve 3-year terms.
- At least three seats are up for election each year on a rotating basis.

Directors who serve **five consecutive 3-year terms** must step off the board and are not eligible to run again for three years.

How to Become a Candidate

To run for the Board, a member must:

- Live in the district they wish to represent.
- Pick up a candidate packet from HCREMC.
- Obtain 30 signatures from members in their district.



Once verified, the candidate's name is **placed on the ballot**.

How the Election Process Works

Director elections are conducted according to board-approved policies to ensure fairness, transparency, and accuracy.

1. Voting Window Opens – Eligible members in the district may cast one vote.
2. Votes Are Tallied – Ballots are counted using established procedures.
3. Ratification Period – All members are given the opportunity to ratify the election results as part of the cooperative governance process.

Why It Matters

Your vote plays an important role in shaping the future of your cooperative. The directors you elect help guide decisions that affect electric rates and financial oversight, system reliability and long-term planning, and the policies and strategic direction that keep Henry County REMC strong and positioned for the future.
