

# Residential Water Heater




Water heating is the second-largest energy expense in most households, accounting for around 18% of the power bill. That means the type of water heater and how you use it is very important. Water heaters and heat pump water heaters have come a long way in efficiency standards. New energy-efficient storage water heaters contain high levels of insulation around the tank to reduce standby heat loss, and heat pump water heaters, like your heat pump HVAC unit, utilize the air around them to heat your water. Both can save you up to \$550 a year.

We understand cost is always a factor when upgrading your equipment so Henry County REMC would like to help you with that by providing a small incentive. Simply fill out the application in its entirety and send it in with your invoice noting manufacturer/brand, model #, and cost of your new water heater and proof of your water heater's UEF rating.

## To Qualify:

- Must be installed in a home served by Henry County REMC
- Limit of two (2) rebates allowed per primary residence per useful life of rebate equipment.
- Minimum UEF rating  $\geq 0.90$  for Wi-Fi enabled electric storage water heaters
- Must submit signed application with itemized invoice/receipt and proof of UEF rating.
- Wi-Fi unit must be built into the water heater when purchased and not a stand-alone equipment piece.
- Incentive amount cannot exceed 50% of equipment cost.
- Please review the complete list of terms and conditions.

# Residential Water Heater Terms & Conditions



## Eligibility Requirements

- Must be a current Henry County REMC residential member-consumer.
- Equipment installations must be in a residential single-family home served by Henry County REMC.
- Applicant must occupy the home where the equipment is installed year-round (12 months).
- Program eligibility includes prior participation in rebate programs, with incentive and measure caps specific for each program. Applications in excess of program caps will not be processed.

## Water Heater Rebate Program Requirements

- The water heater rebate is designed for installation or upgrades of Wi-Fi-enabled electric storage water heaters and heat pump water heaters. Standard electric resistance water heater with no Wi-Fi capabilities built in, tankless water heaters and gas water heaters do not qualify for an incentive.
- All homeowners must provide proof of Uniform Energy Factor (UEF) rating on Wi-Fi enabled electric storage water heaters.
- Submission for water heater rebate must include application, itemized receipt or invoice and picture or certificate noting UEF rating. Applicant should understand no rebate will be given if applicant and/or applicant's contractor fails to provide required documentation.
- Limit of two rebates per primary residence, per the deemed useful life of rebated equipment as determined by Hoosier Energy.

## Program Parameters

- All rebated equipment must be new. Used or rebuilt equipment is not eligible for an incentive.
- Rebated equipment must meet all requirements from the manufacturer's warranty.
- Rebated equipment must meet the technical specifications listed in the application form.
- Applicant agrees to purchase power from Henry County REMC for a period not less than the deemed measured useful life of rebated equipment. Should the applicant receive 100% of their power from any source other than Henry County REMC, including generation owned by the customer before the end of the equipment's deemed useful life, the applicant agrees to refund the full amount of the rebate to Henry County REMC.
- Hoosier Energy maintains full discretion over the rebate and reserves the right to modify the program at any time.

## Application Procedures and Deadlines

- Applications are processed on a first-come, first-served basis while funds are available.
- Submission for rebates must be within 90 days of installation in the same calendar year.
- Applications become the property of Henry County REMC and will not be returned. Please keep a copy for your records.

## Right to Confirm Installation

- Pre-install inspection: Henry County REMC reserves the right to inspect the program participant's premises to verify that equipment meeting program qualifications exists prior to providing an incentive. The program participant agrees to provide reasonable access to the premises for such purposes.
- Post-install inspection: Henry County REMC reserves the right to inspect the program participant's premises to verify that equipment matching the information provided on the program application has been placed in service at that location. The program participant agrees to provide reasonable access to the premises for such purposes.
- Post-inspection: The program participant will have 30 days from the request date to submit any additional information requested by Henry County REMC. Failure to submit requested information may result in application rejection.

- If any requested inspection finds the program participant or the program participant's contractor did not comply with program rules and standards, any incentive received must be returned to Henry County REMC within 60 days of notice of such inspection.
- Henry County REMC reserves the right to conduct an additional post-install inspection for program portfolio evaluation, measurement and verification (EM&V) purposes. Incentives received will not be affected by the results of this inspection.

## **Incentive Payments**

- Henry County REMC reserves the right to approve or deny incentive.
- The incentive payment cannot exceed 50% of the total equipment cost. Installation, taxes and fees cannot be included in the equipment cost.
- Rebates may take up to six weeks from receipt of the application by Henry County REMC to process.
- Approved rebates will be returned to the applicant in the form of a check by mail, via the U.S. Postal Service, or through a bill credit.
- Application approval is not a guarantee of incentive payment.
- Henry County REMC reserves the right to withhold payment for products that do not meet the program requirements as determined within its sole discretion.
- Henry County REMC is not liable for incentives promised to members as a result of a contractor misrepresenting or not verifying the rules of the program. Only Henry County REMC has the right to approve an application and the incentives.
- Incentives are paid as a one-time, one-program offer and cannot be combined with incentive payments, rebates, or discount programs from other utility providers.

- Program applicants and program participants may not use any member cooperative or Hoosier Energy logo or name without prior express written permission.
